ABSTINENCE & FASTING

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence—NO MEAT. Fasting—, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59.
