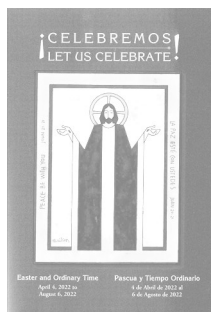

Currently St. Benedict contributions are \$5685.00 and 34 donors at 8.5%

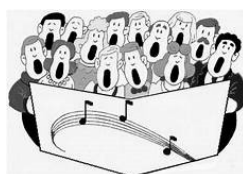
